REGISTRATION OF PORT USERS FOR 2017 PORT OF HONIARA / PORT OF NORO

Solomon Island Port Authority wishes to advise all Port Users that applications are being called for the registration of Port Users for the calendar year 2017. The new Port User Licence will supersede the current entry pass issued at a cost of SBD 500 per each visit into port facilities. The new Port User License will be valid for a period of one year with one time registration and application processing fee. Registered Port Users will be given unlimited access to port premises to carry business with ease subject to rules and regulations of the Port Authority.

Registration of Port Users will commence from 10th March 2017. Application forms can be downloaded from **Solomon Islands Port Authority website** <http://www.sipa.com.sb> or obtained free of charge from the reception/ cashiers desk of SIPA office, Dowling Street, Point Cruz, Honiara and from SIPA Noro office during office hours from Monday to Friday from 8am – 4.30pm from the date of this notice.

Registration deadline for all Port Users will be 10th April 2017 and there will be no additional charge for entry into port premises during the interim period. Entry during the interim period is subject to approval based on the necessity to enter into port and presentation of a valid company identification card. All Port Users are encouraged to register on or before the deadline to avoid any inconvenience.
